

Jacob Christian Jørgensen

Jacob C. Jørgensen is a Danish lawyer and arbitrator with extensive international experience in disputes related to onshore construction projects and offshore wind farm projects. Jacob holds an LL.M. in international commercial law from the University of Cambridge (Jesus College) as well as a BA and an MA in law from the University of Copenhagen. He has been a member of the Danish Bar for more than 20 years and earned the right of audience in the Danish Supreme Court in 2013. In 2018, he served as a High Court Judge (pro tem) in the Eastern Division of the Danish High Court. He is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, a CAS arbitrator and is listed as a Certified Adjudicator on FIDIC's "President's List". Jacob has served as an arbitrator under the ICC rules, the rules of the Court of Arbitration for Sport, the rules of the Danish Institute of Arbitration and in ad hoc arbitrations. He regularly publishes within his areas of expertise and speaks at international conferences and as a guest lecturer at the University of Copenhagen. In 2023, Jacob joined FIDIC's Task Group 14, which is drafting a new standard contract for offshore wind projects.
