- Has conducted a large number of arbitration cases (both national and international cases under FIDIC rules) for arbitration courts, Dispute Adjudication Boards, etc.

- Has served as party-appointed arbitrator in numerous cases across various legal domains.

As an arbitrator I have mostly been involved in commercial disputes regarding large scale investments in infrastructure, tech and oil/gas facilities, and the interpretation of ownership agreements and stock trade agreements, in a wide variety of industries. The roles have included both ad hoc arbitration and institutional arbitration, the latter through appointments from the Danish Bar Association, the Danish Arbitration Institute, and from ICC and SCC.
